Notes on Initial Observed Drive:

During the initial drive, Simon drove to a good standard. His speed in urban areas was very well controlled. However, he did display a lack of mirror use on approach to hazards. He is certainly a confident driver and has overall good car control. However, on occasions he did drive with one hand on the steering wheel, and the other on the gearstick, which he admitted had become habit.

Space management in urban traffic could be improved, as at times he didn't give adequate space between his car and the hazard.
